### **Connect Your Classroom Community with** Harmony Everyday Practices

Harmony Everyday Practices foster inclusive social connections among students and promote the social, emotional, and cognitive skills, knowledge, and attitudes students need to develop positive peer relationships and thrive academically. This multi-layered approach includes:

- Harmony Goals Create Harmony Goals with students that reflect how everyone wants to interact and be treated by one another similar to group agreements, expectations, or a class pledge.
- Meet Up Gather students in a forum to establish and monitor Harmony Goals, share experiences, solve problems, and build community.
- Buddy Up Create intentional opportunities for students to get to know one another, form connections, collaborate, and learn together with this peer buddy system.
