
# WELCOME HOME

## STUDENTS LOVE OUR COMPACT, PICTURESQUE CAMPUS.

Sixty-six percent of on-campus students live within a two-minute walk of the Quad. Walk to class, grab lunch on Main Street, and then stroll into Uptown to catch a movie.

- 1 Hancock Stadium is home to the Redbird football team, a perennial power in Division I football.
- 2 The Main Street corridor is where you'll find great eats like Avanti's, Chipotle, Meatheads, Noodles & Company, Potbelly, McDonald's, Pizza Hut, and Buffalo Wild Wings.
- The Student Fitness Center has earned recognition for being one of the best in the nation.
- 4 Come visit us and stop by The Atrium at the Bone Student Center to take a tour of campus!
- Check out the Bird's Eye View from the top of Watterson Towers. Get a breathtaking perspective of campus from the tallest building between Chicago and St. Louis.
- Uptown Normal offers restaurants, boutique shops, a theater, access to a 49-mile bike trail, and the multimodal transportation center for travel by bus and train.

Go for a run or ride on the 49-mile Constitution Trail. Borrow a bike from the Student Fitness Center or use your own.



When considering a college, find out what support systems are in place to make sure you graduate on time and are prepared for life as a professional.



You're concerned about the cost of college. So are we. More than 79 percent of our students receive financial aid to help make their Illinois State dream a reality. Fall 2021 incoming freshmen with at least a 3.3 GPA will receive a merit-based scholarship. Additionally, once you start, your tuition rate will be locked in for four years, allowing you to plan for the future.

Redbird Academic Scholarship	Up to \$20,000 total \$1,000-\$5,000 per year	3.3/4.0 GPA	Submission of scholarship form encouraged for full consideration

## Other scholarships include our

McLean County Full Tuition Scholarship, Legacy Scholarship, International Baccalaureate Scholarship, and Achievement Scholarship.

Qualified incoming freshmen should apply for admission no later than November 15 for best consideration. Students with a strong academic background whose profile does not fit the above criteria may also be considered for scholarships.
