

- 3. Competitive test scores on the Medical College Admissions Test (MCAT) earned no more than 3 years prior to the planned enrollment year
- 4. Two letters of recommendation (one letter must be from a D.O. or M.D.)

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Students may obtain American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine Application Service (AACOMAS) applications as early as May 1st of the academic year preceding the year in which they plan to apply. To be competitive in our rolling admissions process, students should apply as early as possible. The official AACOMAS deadline for completed applications for fall enrollment is **January 1st**.


