THE 4-YEAR PROGRAM

The Army ROTC program is offered in addition to your regular college classes and allows you to pursue almost any major you choose. The first two years of Army ROTC course electives are the Basic Course, followed by the two final years of the Advanced Course. During the summer between your junior and senior years, your leadership training will be put to the test during an intensive five-week Leader Development and Assessment Course (LDAC).

THE 2-YEAR PROGRAM

This is an accelerated path toward becoming an Army officer. You may apply for this option if you have completed your studies at a junior college or community college; you are entering a two-year postgraduate program; you are a high school student planning to attend a military junior college; or you are entering your junior year of college. To qualify for the final two years of the Army ROTC Advanced Course, you must first attend and complete a four-week Leader's Training Course.

NURSING. A commission as an officer in the Army Nurse Corps through ROTC means you have undergone valuable hands-on experience while developing your management and teamwork skills – skills highly prized by the world's finest hospitals. Learn more at goarmy.com/rotc.

SIMULTANEOUS MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM (SMP). This is for those who wish to join the Army National Guard or the Army Reserve while enrolled in Army ROTC. In most cases, these branches require a two-year commitment. Learn more at goarmy.com/reserve/benefits.

GREEN TO GOLD. If you're currently on active duty or have completed your service, you may already have fulfilled the requirements for the Basic Course. You may enroll directly in the Advanced Course and complete ROTC in just two years. Learn more at goarmy.com/rotc/enlisted-soldiers.html.

BE RECOGNIZED FOR YOUR MERIT

Do you have a distinguished academic record? Have you participated in after-school activities or even worked a part-time job? Are you physically active? 4-YEAR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR HIGH
SCHOOL STUDENTS

The application process begins February 1 of your junior year and should be submitted by January 10 of your senior year. Applications submitted past this date will be considered but may not be as competitive due to selection time frames.
