

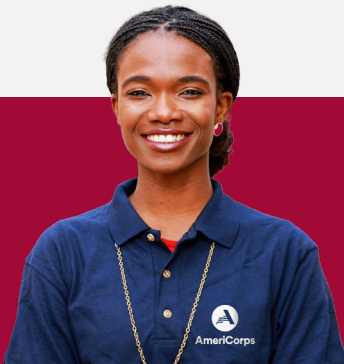

What is Kentucky College Coaches?



Kentucky College Coaches is a statewide AmeriCorps program that places screened, high value mentors in both secondary and post-secondary schools to support college access and student success. These AmeriCorps service members are tasked with acting as coaches to selected students, helping them be successful in all aspects of their school career.

What do Kentucky College Coaches do?



High School

At the high school level, mentors inspire, encourage, and support students in applying and achieving acceptance into college or vocational training. This involves planning school activities as well as providing one-on-one coaching with students in grades 9 - 12.

College

At the college level, mentors plan campus events and activities that promote career readiness, student retention and engagement, and college completion.
