

HOW DO I MAKE THE CASE FOR STARTING ROX?

Girls are struggling with low self-confidence, having difficulty managing stress, pressure & anxiety, lacking representation in STEM and AP courses, managing intense conflict with other girls & attempting to navigate social media. These challenges are holding girls back from reaching their full potential.

- Training is \$600 and is inclusive of all materials.
