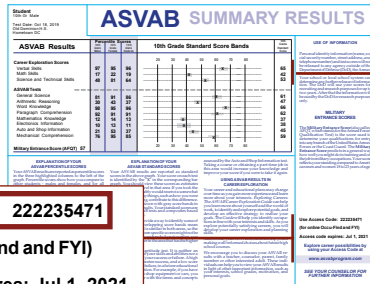

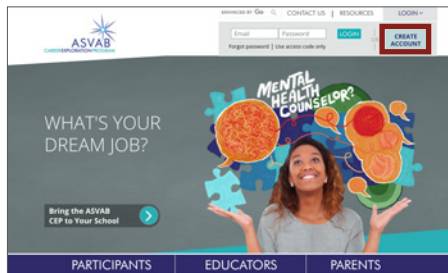

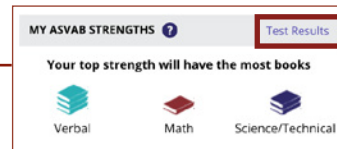

**Important:** Students can register their access codes using an email and password on first **login**. They can use the same login credentials on both [www.asvabprogram.com](http://www.asvabprogram.com) and [www.careersinthemilitary.com](http://www.careersinthemilitary.com). They will have access to the websites for two years and don't have to worry about losing their ASR.

## SCORES

Career Exploration Scores are represented using books. Select **See Test Results** to view full score report.

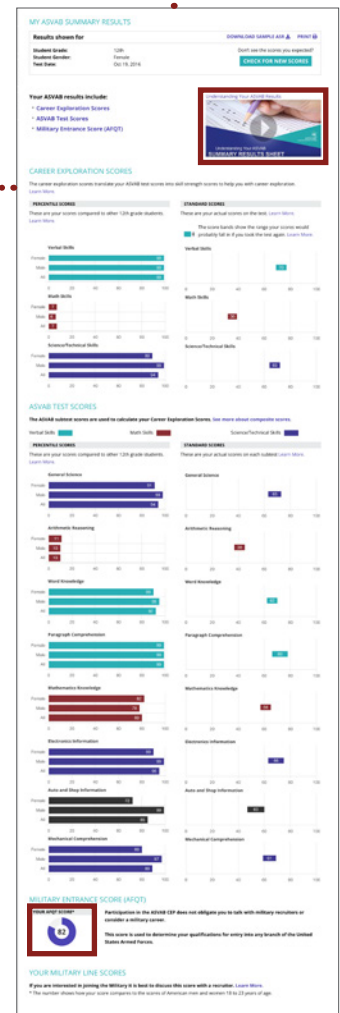


3 books = Highest Score  
2 books = 2<sup>nd</sup> Highest Score  
1 book = 3<sup>rd</sup> Highest Score  
\* Equal books = Tied Scores

**Important:** Scores pulled from the system populate all subtest scores, including **AFQT**, and books appear in color. Scores entered manually display gray books, and no subtest or AFQT scores are populated.

Students do not fail the ASVAB. Their scores may not qualify them for service or a particular job, but that does not exclude them from using their scores to explore careers.




## LEARN

Identifying interests is the next step in finding potentially satisfying career options.

Select **Take the FYI** within the “Learn About Yourself” tab and watch the **Taking the FYI** tutorial.

Then, select **LET’S GET STARTED** to take the FYI.



**FIND YOUR INTERESTS DIRECTIONS**

- With interest inventories, there are no right or wrong answers.
- For each of the activities in the FYI, ask yourself if you would like or dislike doing that activity.
- Don't be concerned with how well you would do any activity or whether you have the experience or training to do it.
- Go with the first answer that comes to mind.
- If you don't have a strong preference one way or the other, or you are unsure, you can answer Indifferent.


Select **L** for Like (I would like to do this activity.)





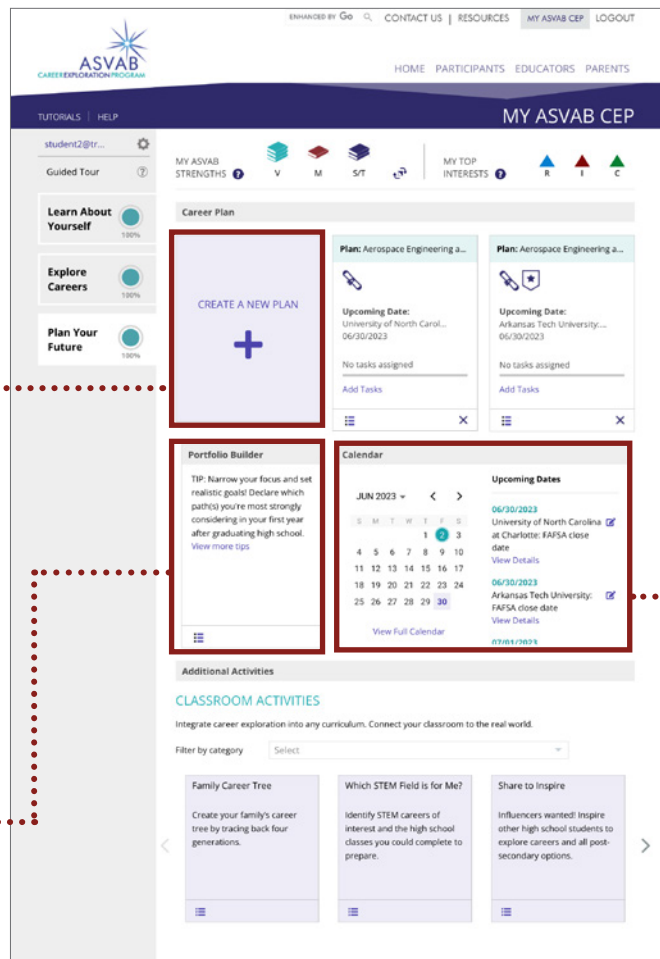
The federal government employs many JOB TITLE. There are numerous advantages of working for the federal government and multiple career paths are available.

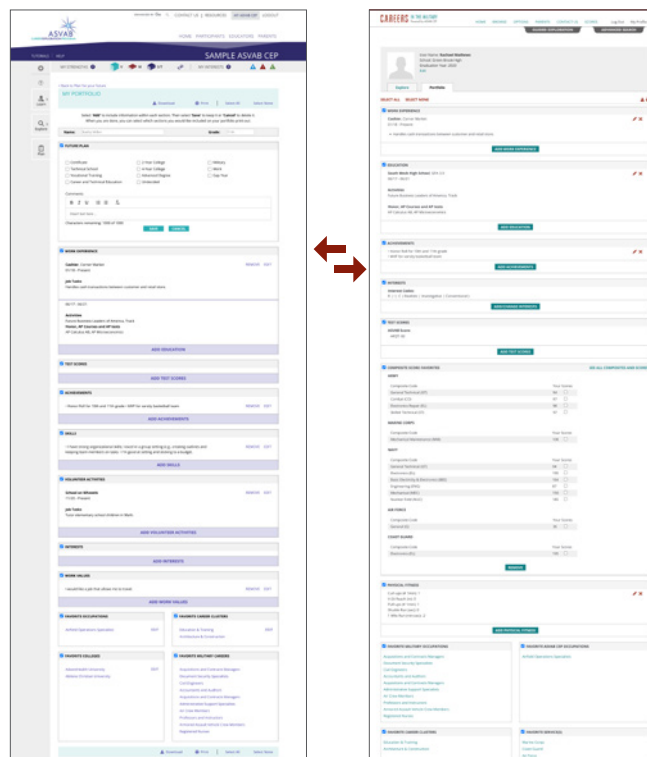
## CALENDAR

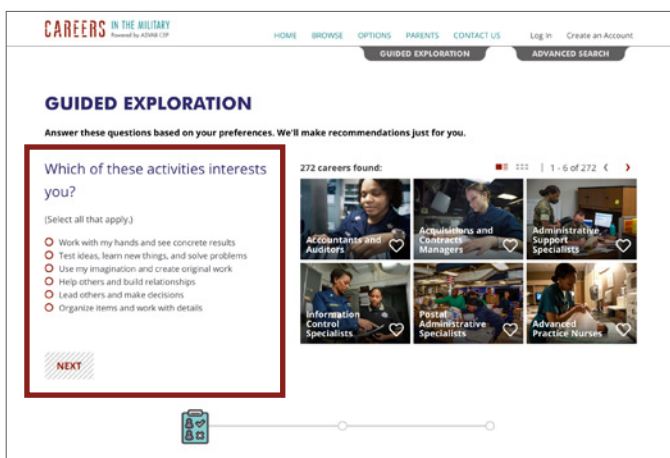
