Open Access

Open Access means we encourage individuals who need quality services and are new to Monarch to simply walk in for the first visit without an appointment.

What You Can Expect

Upon arrival, we will complete a comprehensive clinical assessment and treatment plan. If needed, a psychiatric evaluation, prescription and/or a referral to the proper level of care will be provided.

While this process takes longer than a traditional appointment, it reduces what could otherwise be months of waiting.

What You Need to Know

- Walk-ins are welcome. No appointment is needed for the first visit.
- Individuals can be in therapy the next day.

What We Need to Know

- Person’s presenting problem or condition
- Current medications
- Person’s medical and treatment history
- Insurance or payment information
