SCHOLARSHIPS

Merit Scholarships

These scholarships recognize academic merit and help qualified undergraduate students finance their college degrees. Award is based on the applicant's GPA. Incoming freshmen and transfer students must complete and submit their applications to attend Kean by May 30 to be considered.

Kean University Foundation Scholarships

New and incoming students can review scholarships available through the Kean University Foundation. Students who meet the donor criteria are encouraged to apply. The application for Kean University Foundation Scholarships opens on October 1. Submit your FAFSA early, as it may be needed for some scholarship considerations.

Freshman Application Requirements

- Provide official high school transcript indicating 16 college preparatory courses, including: four English, three mathematics, two history, two lab sciences and five approved electives in social studies, science, mathematics or foreign languages.
- Submitting SAT and ACT test scores is optional. Students may opt to submit SAT scores in consideration of scholarships and placement test waiver(s). You may send us an official score report using Kean's College Entrance Examination Board (CEEB) code 2517.

Recommended:

- Two letters of recommendation
- Personal essay expressing your educational and professional career goals
- List of your high school activities and/or work experiences

Transfer Application Requirements

- Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions
- Final high school transcript if you have not earned an associate degree

International Application Requirements

- A course-by-course evaluation (with GPA) of official high school (secondary school) transcript of mark sheet (first-year applicants)
- A course-by-course evaluation of any official university transcripts (transfer applicants)
- Evaluation report(s) must be sent from organization(s) affiliated with the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES)
- A TOEFL/IELTS/Duolingo score report
- Recommended submission is three months before the term begins

* **An audition/portfolio review is required** for Michael Graves College (Robert Busch School of Design and School of Public Architecture) and for the Department of Fine Arts, Department of Music and Department of Theatre.
