Sunday, November 2 | 4:00 p.m. Navigating Ethical and Legal Dilemmas in Counseling Carolyn Stone

ABOUT THIS SESSION: Navigating the complex balance between the needs of the school environment, students' confidentiality rights, and parents' legal authority in guiding their children's lives is challenging. In today's climate, these issues are even more pronounced. This session will provide updates on current legal issues and court rulings that impact practice. Topics will include rulings on First Amendment rights,

transgender youth, undocumented students, child abuse reporting, Parents' Bill of Rights, chaplains in schools, student speech, and other emerging matters. Participants will gain legal literacy and guiding principles to support the best legal and ethical practices in their work."

SPEAKER BIO: Carolyn Stone, Ed.D., is a Professor Emeritus of Counselor Education at the University of North Florida (UNF). Dr. Stone is a Past President of the American School Counselor Association (ASCA), and in 2010 was presented the ASCA Lifetime Achievement Award. Prior to coming to UNF, Dr. Stone spent 22 years with Jacksonville, Florida's Public Schools as an elementary and high school counselor, middle school teacher and Supervisor of Guidance Services. She supervised 225 school counselors. Dr. Stone was ASCAs Ethics Chair from 2002 to 2022 and chaired the last four revisions of the ethical standards.


Unstoppable Self-Care: Harnessing Your Strength to Overcome Burnout Amid Serving Others
