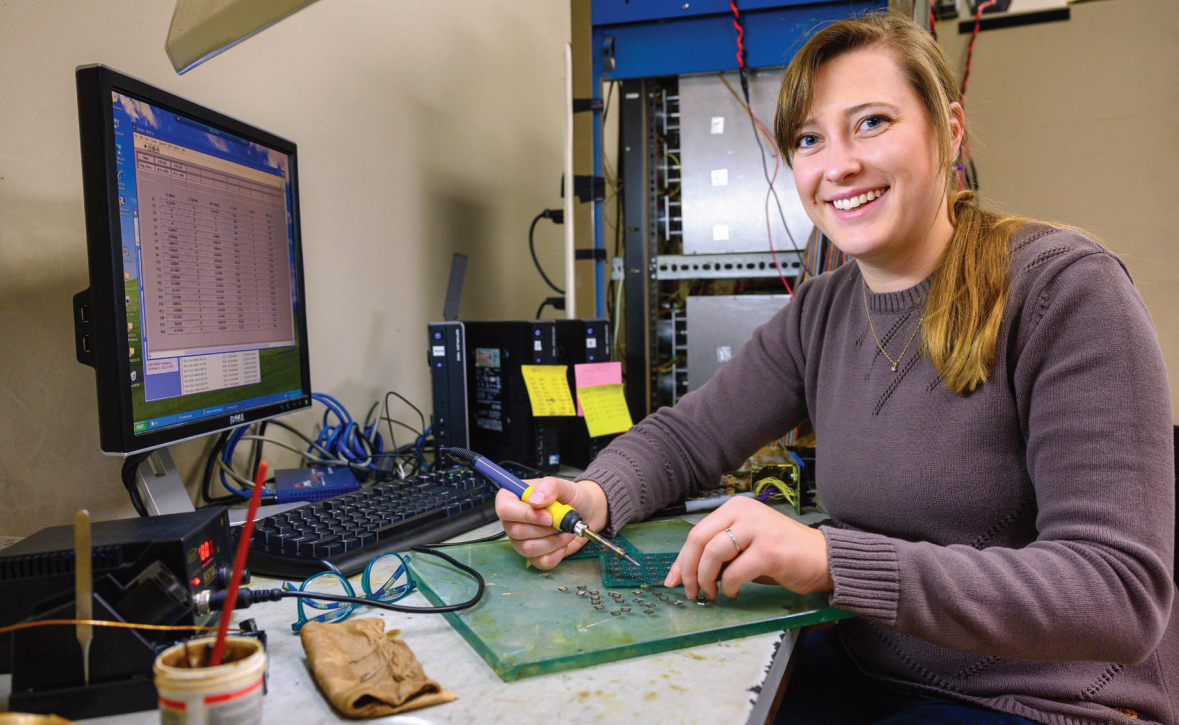

● HOW TO APPLY

- Complete your application using the Common App at commonapp.org (preferred) or ApplyTexas at applytexas.org.
- Self-report your academic record (SRAR), which is preferred, or submit official high school transcripts with GPA included at go.uta.edu/submitting-transcripts.
Note: To be considered for merit-based scholarships, you must complete SRAR.
- Submit official SAT or ACT scores (optional, but encouraged).*
- Submit the application fee or fee waiver.

2025 APPLICATION PRIORITY DATES

- Applications are accepted after the published priority date for each term, but for guaranteed consideration of admission, please submit the application and associated materials by the priority date. Meeting priority deadlines will guarantee that you receive your admissions decision in time to get early access to dedicated admitted student events, academic advising, enrollment in classes, new maverick orientation registration and much more!

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- In addition to meeting regular admissions criteria, you must submit official TOEFL test scores if you are from a non-native English speaking country. The minimum acceptable TOEFL score is 79 on the internet-based test. For IELTS, we require a minimum score of 6.5. UTA also accepts Duolingo with a required minimum score of 100.

*Minimum unweighted on a 4.0 scale.

**Scores listed are the minimum required scores. The SAT score is calculated by combining the highest Evidence-Based Reading, Writing, and Math scores. The ACT is the composite score, which includes the English, Reading, Math, and Science sections. UTA does not require an essay. If you apply for admission without these test scores, your application will be evaluated based on high school records. Please note that test scores can help in determining admission decisions, testing requirements, and scholarship opportunities.

***Numbers listed are the minimum. Advanced credits include dual enrollment, AP, IB, and honors.

****If you have 23 credit hours or less, you are considered to be a freshman student and must meet freshman and transfer admissions requirements.

March 1
To be considered for merit-based scholarships, students must apply by the priority application deadline and be admitted by the scholarship deadline.

NEED-BASED FINANCIAL AID PRIORITY DATE
March 1

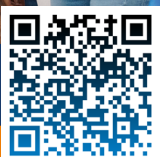
