



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- In addition to meeting regular admissions criteria, you must submit official TOEFL test scores if you are from a non-native English speaking country. The minimum acceptable TOEFL score is 79 on the internet-based test. For IELTS, we require a minimum score of 6.5. UTA also accepts Duolingo with a required minimum score of 100.

*Minimum unweighted on a 4.0 scale.

⁺⁺Scores listed are the minimum required scores. The SAT score is calculated by combining the highest Evidence-Based Reading, Writing, and Math scores. The ACT is the composite score, which includes the English, Reading, Math, and Science sections. UTA does not require an essay. If you apply for admission without these test scores, your application will be evaluated based on high school records. Please note that test scores can help in determining admission decisions, testing requirements, and scholarship opportunities.




