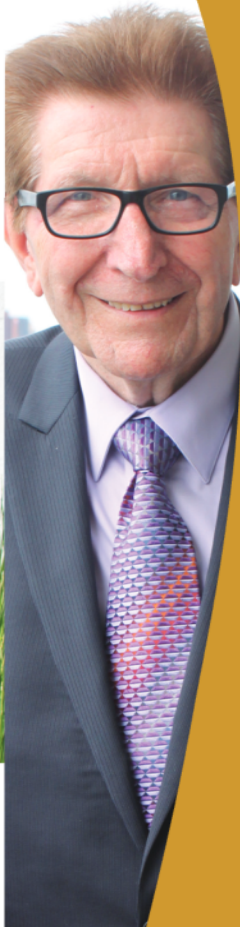

PUTTING STUDENTS BACK ON TRACK

Step Up is a dropout prevention program allowing eligible students who qualify in grades 6–12 to enroll any time, tuition free. Once enrolled, all students are assigned an advocate. Advocates make regular contact with each student and craft an educational development plan for them to begin earning a diploma as soon as possible.

All students earn a high school diploma upon completion and are awarded a \$500 scholarship to continue their education at an institution of higher learning. We support students who believe in furthering their education after high school.

WHO CAN ENROLL IN THE STEP UP PROGRAM?

A student qualifies for Step Up if they are:

- At risk of dropping out of school
- Pregnant or a parent
- Referred by the juvenile justice system
- Expelled from school
- At least one semester or trimester behind in credits



WHAT IS REQUIRED?

The minimum student requirements for Step Up are:

- Complete one class each month
- Maintain weekly contact with their Advocate
- Complete at least four (4) classes and two (2) months in Step Up to be eligible to graduate with a high school diploma

CREDIT RECOVERY and CREDIT ENRICHMENT

Our Online Credit Recovery & Enhancement Program lets students retake failed courses or advance academically.

Flexible, self-paced, and accredited, it offers 24/7 access, tutoring support, and transferable credits. Enroll, complete coursework, pass exams, and stay on track for graduation.

HOW IT WORKS

All the classes are delivered online. Once enrolled, each student is assigned an academic coach who contacts them twice per week to discuss progress and provide advice. They also call parent(s)/guardian(s) twice a week to keep them informed of the student's progress. If tutoring is needed, assistance is provided over the telephone or online face-to-face.

Q&A

Q: Who can enroll?

A: Students from high schools across the United States are able to enroll.

Q: When can I enroll?

A: Students can enroll any time during the year.

Q: How much does the program cost?

A: If the student is under the age of 22 all classes are \$300.

Q: How long are the courses?

A: Each course has a duration of eight weeks.

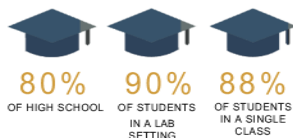
