EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

MONEY FOR COLLEGE



The cost of higher education should not stop you from reaching your goals in life. In addition to your monthly drill pay and allowances, the Army National Guard offers numerous educational benefits including:

- Federal Tuition Assistance
- State Tuition Assistance
- GI Bill Programs
- Student Loan Repayment Program
- Free Education Counseling Services
- Free Academic Tests: GED, ACT, SAT, GMAT, GRE, and Praxis
- Free College Credit Equivalency Exams: CLEP and DSST

TUITION ASSISTANCE **PROGRAMS**



FEDERAL - The Federal Tuition Assistance Program assists with the cost of tuition up to \$250 per credit hour up to 16 credit hours per year subject to availability of funds.

STATE - Exclusive to Indiana National Guard members is the National Guard Supplemental Grant (NGSG) which is available immediately upon becoming a member. This state program is for Guard members pursuing undergraduate degrees at Indiana public institutions. NGSG alone covers up to 100% tuition and some fees for 15 credit hours per semester.

STUDENT LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM



The Student Loan Repayment Program may pay up to \$50,000 for certain jobs with a six year enlistment. To qualify, applicants must have eligible student loans at the time of enlistment.



MONTGOMERY GI BILL

Under the Montgomery GI Bill - Selected Reserve (MGIB-SR), you receive a monthly payment toward the cost of attending school. Current payment amounts are available at www.gibill.va.gov.

In addition to the MGIB-SR, you may also qualify for the MGIB "Kicker" by enlisting in certain jobs with a six year enlistment. This program provides an additional \$200 or \$350 per month toward the costs of going to school.





COLLEGE FIRST ENLISTMENT OPTION

The Army National Guard College First enlistment option provides Non-Prior Service applicants the opportunity to serve part-time in the ARNG and complete up to two years of full-time schooling with no federal deployment/mobilization. Applicants that enlist under this option may be stabilized for up to 24 months upon completion of Initial Active Duty Training (which is where you learn the skills required for the military job, or MOS, you select when you enlist).



COLLEGE CREDITS FOR TRAINING

In the Army National Guard, you can earn college credits for completion of your military training. Many academic institutions award college credit for various types of military training.
