Expert Care, Compassionate Support

While enrolled in our programs, you will be cared for by an interdisciplinary team of mental health experts who are compassionate and committed to your well-being.

Psychiatrist ensures that your medication regimen is supporting your recovery.

Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant provides therapeutic evaluations and psychoeducation.

Registered Nurse provides additional medical and nursing support.

Masters-level Trained Clinician serves as your primary and group therapist.

Client Services Coordinator walks you through the admissions process.

Behavioral Health Tech provides milieu support and assists therapists with case management and aftercare planning.

Education Facilitator helps students stay on track with schoolwork during treatment.

Occupational Therapist supports you in building practical skills and strategies to navigate daily life with greater independence and confidence.

Guidelight operates in Massachusetts as a mental health services clinic licensed to provide Psychiatric Day Treatment, which is sometimes described by insurers as intensive outpatient programs ("IOP") or partial hospitalization programs ("PHP"). Guidelight is not currently certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services ("CMS") as an IOP or PHP.
