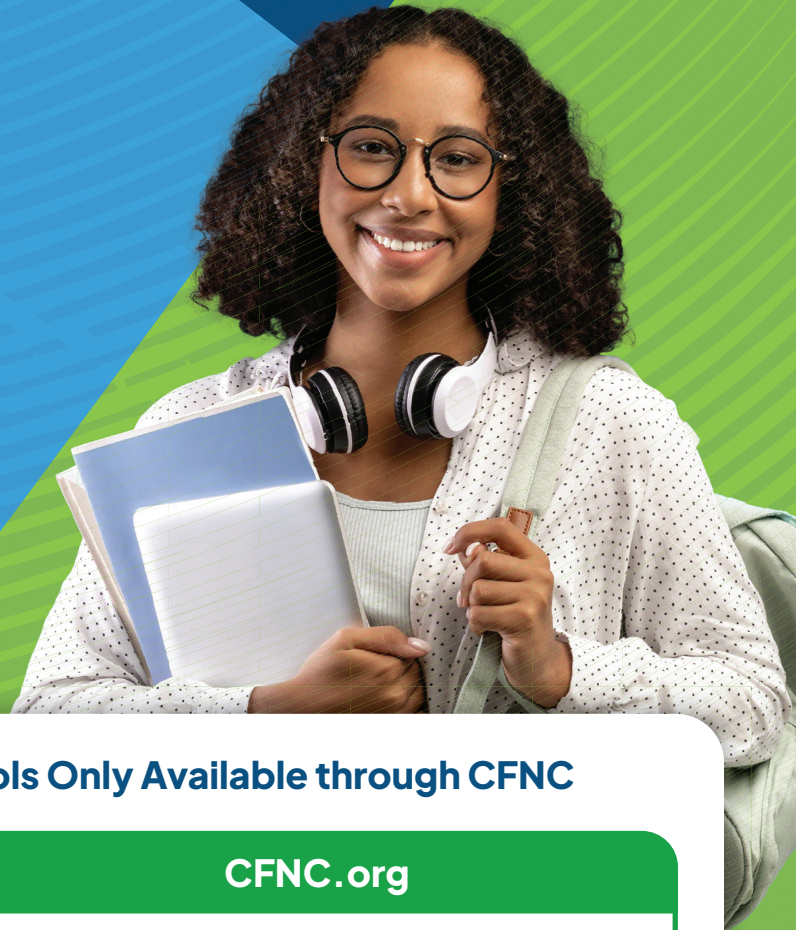

College for North Carolina (CFNC) is a free service of the State of North Carolina, here to support you with exclusive resources and guidance as you help students plan for their future after graduation.



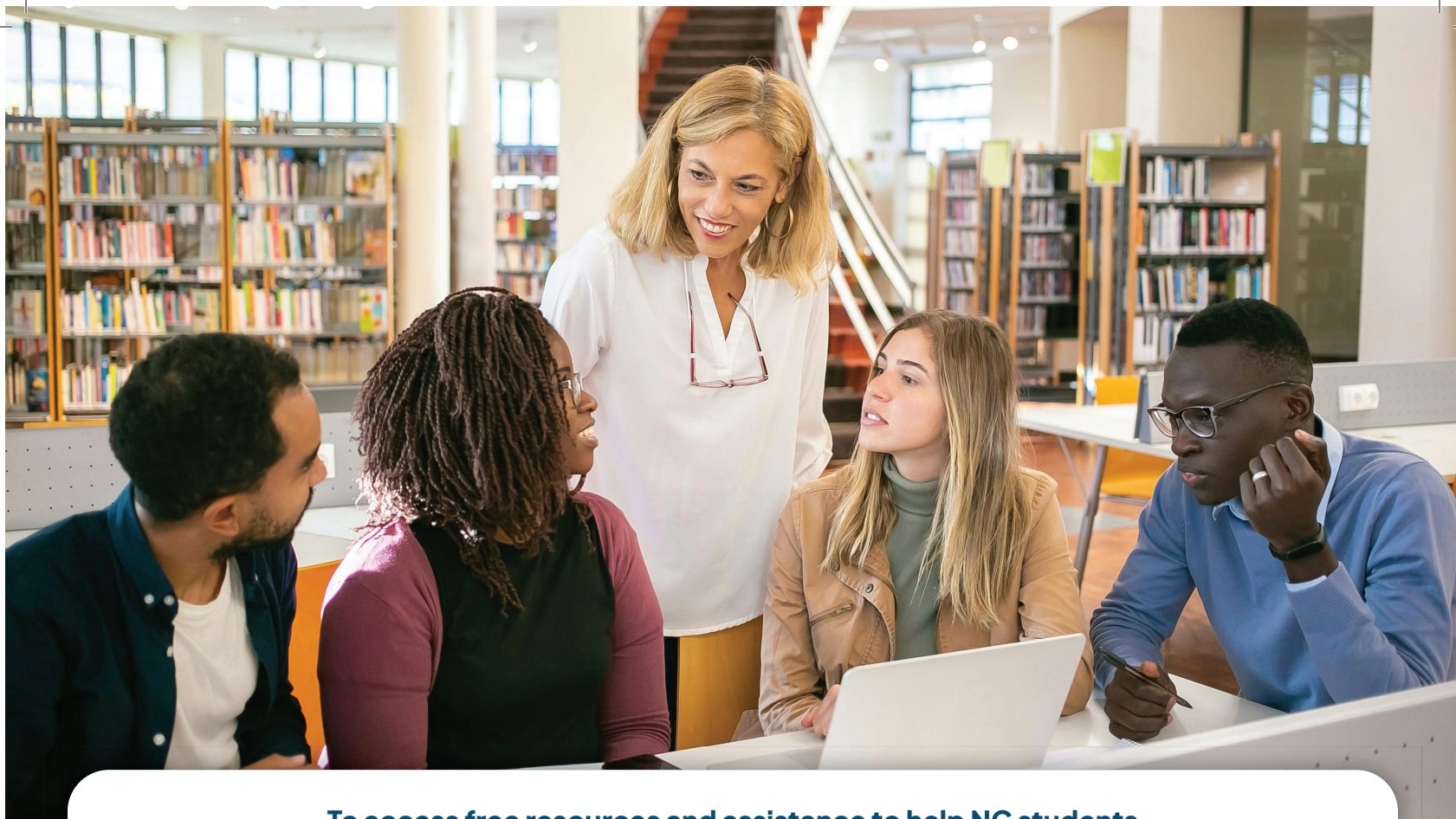
Free College and Career Planning Tools Only Available through CFNC

Train the Trainer Programming

- Professional development opportunities and programs that offer Continuing Education Units (CEUs).
- CFNC ProTools—Track student progress on important college steps, including:
 - Requesting high school transcripts.
 - Completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and NC Residency Determination Service (NC RDS).
 - Submitting college applications.
 - Completing career assessments.
- Access to the FAFSA Tracker and Finish the FAFSA to help students make the cost of college more manageable.
- Information and assistance around ways to pay for education, including scholarships, grants, student loans, and NC 529 Plan.
- Planning resources for the Next Step program that helps juniors take action toward their next step after graduation.
- Helpful tools you can use to help students find their interests, explore occupations, and plan for careers.

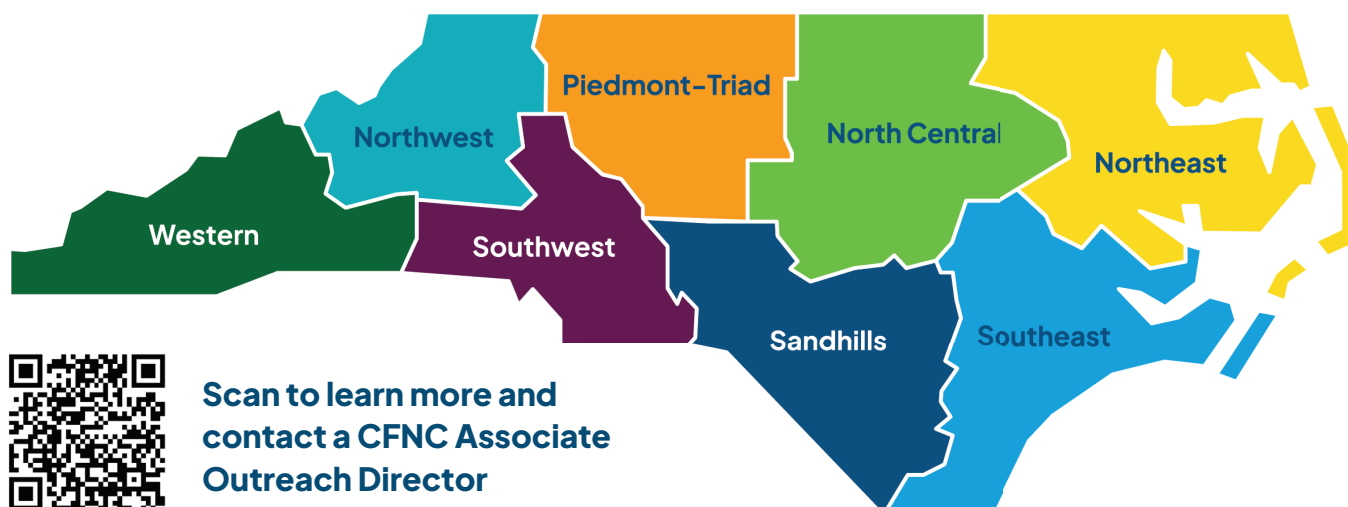
- Information on NC Countdown to College (C2C), a year-long initiative to help high school students, their families, and adult learners understand and complete the three college enrollment steps: residency, financial aid, and college applications.

- Information on Direct Admission opportunities, guides on how to transfer colleges, and programs for adult and independent learners.
- One-stop-shop for toolkits and other resources designed for education professionals, by education professionals.
- CFNC Scholarship Search, College Search, and Financial Aid Calculators to help students prepare and pay for college.
