School counselors work directly with the Indiana Online Student Services Team, who provide wrap-around support for all courses and programs. ACCREDITATION



Indiana Online has achieved dual accreditation through AccredVEd, powered by the Virtual Learning Leadership Alliance (VLLA) and Cognia. This milestone follows a rigorous review process meticulously aligned with the National Standards for Quality (NSQ) Online Programs.



This included providing evidence of meeting the benchmarks of rubrics covering all 72 indicators within the NSQ Online Program standards, comprehensive data collection protocols, and a peer review process to ensure rigorous evaluation and alignment. As a result, Indiana Online has become the first organization in the nation to achieve this new accreditation, marking a significant milestone in our commitment to high-quality online education.

The accreditation review process was organized into four key clusters:

1. Stakeholder Supports
2. Mission, Governance, and Leadership
3. Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment
4. Planning, Resources, and Evaluation



These clusters ensure a comprehensive evaluation of virtual learning programs, emphasizing strategic alignment and quality in all aspects. Meeting the requirements for each cluster leads to a program's certification in that area, and a program achieves full virtual learning program accreditation upon earning all four certifications.

CERTIFICATIONS

Indiana Online has received certification from Quality Matters for several courses by successfully meeting Quality Matters K-12 Content Rubric Standards. Content standards review academic standard alignment to lessons and assessments, breadth, depth, and rigor, along with accessibility. Indiana Online continues to submit courses for certification, actively seeking recognition for high-enrollment courses through Quality Matters.

OUR COURSE DEVELOPMENT

One semester online courses developed through Indiana Online undergo a rigorous process, using the expertise of subject matter experts, instructional designers, and a master reviewer for Quality Matters. Each semester of a course is developed over a six month period. An annual review process is also built into all course development.

1 Course Selection

Course is identified for development or revision. Requests are based on state standards, student input, and known course access issues.

2 Subject Matter Expert Selected

Subject Matter Experts who are licensed in the subject and have successfully completed the Course Developer course are hired to serve as course writers.

3 Writing Process Begins

Subject Matter Experts meet with the Instructional Design & Curriculum Manager to start constructing a course alignment document correlating Indiana Academic Standards with lessons and assessments using ADDIE, UBD, and UDL.

4 Instructional Designer Constructs Course

Instructional Designer builds the online course in Canvas, starting with our Quality Matters Certified Course Template, then adds lessons and assessments created by Subject Matter Experts.

5 Quality Assurance

The Instructional Design & Curriculum Manager and full-time teacher review and revise the course using the Quality Matters K-12 Rubric and NSQ for Online Courses.

6 Course Reviewed & Finalized

Subject Matter Experts complete a curriculum review of the course.

7 Course Release

After final checks, the online course is released for student enrollment.

8 Course Review

Course is reviewed annually by Indiana Online. The review includes data analysis and feedback from students and teachers.
