High ability students often experience school differently. They may learn quickly, think deeply, notice patterns others miss, or ask questions that go far beyond the lesson in front of them. But advanced ability does not mean they automatically know how to manage challenge, frustration, perfectionism, pressure, or the feeling of being different from their peers. Some high ability students thrive academically while struggling socially or emotionally; others hide their ability, underperform, or disengage when school does not feel meaningful. Counselors are in a unique position to recognize these needs and help students feel seen, supported, and understood. IAG membership gives counselors a place to learn more about the academic and social/emotional characteristics of high ability learners, connect with others who care about these students, and gain practical support for helping them navigate school with confidence and a stronger sense of belonging.
