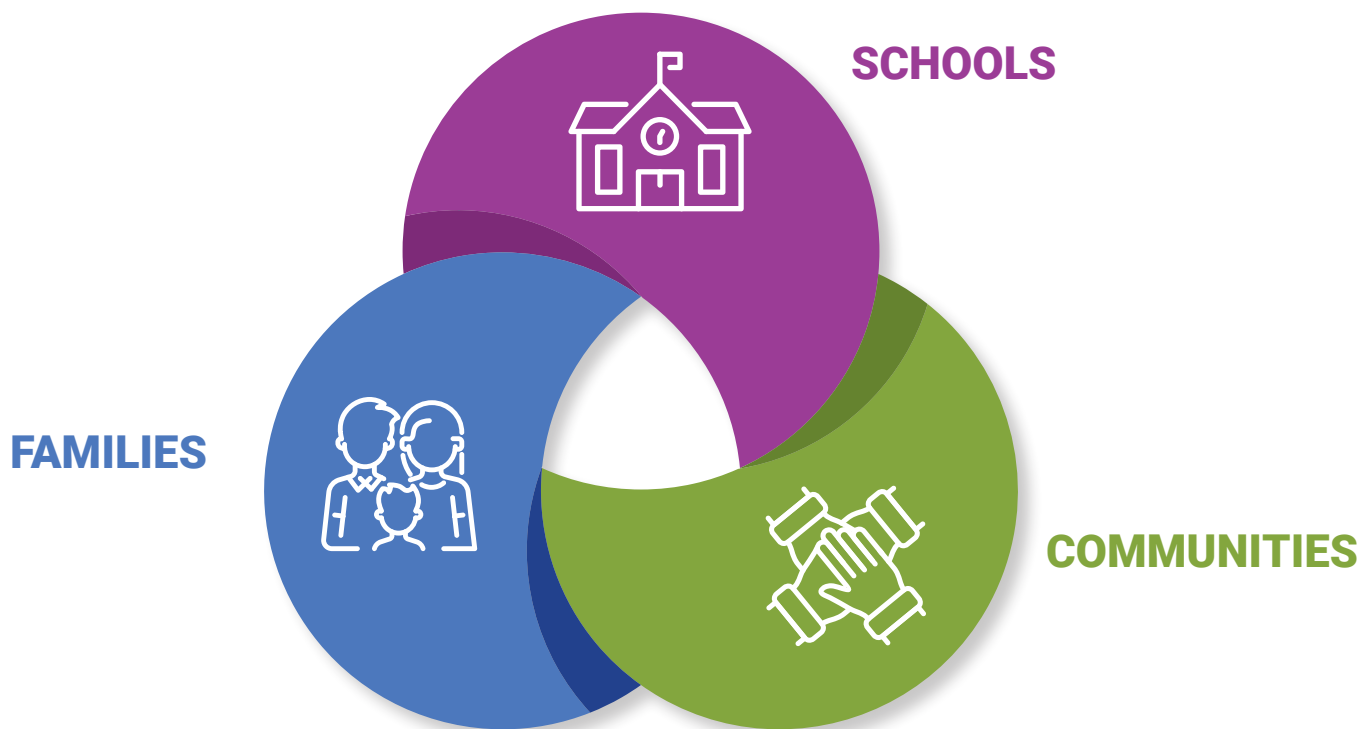


Harmony Academy and Wraparound Support: Strengthening Relationships Across Schools, Families, and Out-of-School Time

Why Harmony Matters for Wraparound Support:

Students thrive when their academic, relational, and personal needs are supported in consistent and connected ways across their day. Providing wraparound support that places the whole child at the center ensures young people experience care, belonging, and consistency across school, home, and their communities. Harmony Academy strengthens relationships with self, others, and the community by providing systemic tools that align the efforts of the adults who support young people throughout the day. When schools, families, and community partners use shared routines and practices — and consistent language — districts can create reliable, relationship-centered environments that foster a sense of belonging and whole-child development across all settings.



How Harmony Academy Supports Wraparound Work

Educators, youth development staff, families, and caregivers are all navigating increasing demands while trying to meet young people's needs for belonging, consistency, and safety. Harmony Academy supports adults and young people through tools, routines, and activities grounded in healthy relationship development — encouraging connections across settings. By aligning specific resources to both the need and the setting, adults who support young people can use Harmony to support consistent language, practices, and experiences for young people across systems.
